Director's Update

In September, I traveled to India with Pramod Mathews, my brother, and the longest-serving Love Without Reason Board of Directors member.

Even in a pandemic, children with clefts are born every day, and trafficking of these children happens every day. The trip assessed how to develop new strategies to host medical camps despite the Covid limitations worldwide. Our trip focused on Bangalore, Mumbai, Assam, Coimbatore, and Hyderabad. Through our work building relationships and networks, we have confirmed the continuation of partnerships.

We have the upcoming medical camp in India from November 14-19, 2021. The year 2022 will begin the journey of five medical camps in Kenya, Uganda, Zimbabwe, India, and Tanzania. Each medical camp strives to complete an average of 50 surgeries. The cost of these camps costs **\$75,000** to operate. As we are coming to the end of 2021, we need all the support we can get to help make these surgeries possible. Each \$50 or \$100 matters!

The lack of access to clean water and sanitary products can block women from fully participating in society, which is an issue that impacts everyone. This product will support women in so many aspects of their life.

Even more touching was the time we were able to take with each visit to hear the stories of each family and the little ones' growth into who they have become or are becoming. Despite their hardships, there is great joy in many of these families.

Meeting Mary Bongo was one of my favorite moments. When Mary was born with her cleft, her father wanted nothing to do with her. He refused to send her to school and sold her as a child bride at age 15 to an older man who treated her poorly. After having 8 children, her husband passed away. She was left to provide for all her children while being cast out of society. Barely able to find work and working the most unwanted jobs, she cared for her children.

Mary lived mistreated by her community for 63 years! Then she had surgery to repair her cleft. Mary's daughter found a flyer for LWR's medical camp in 2018 and was selected to have the surgery. Later after our visit, Santhosh and Susan reflected on when they met Mary. She wouldn't look anyone in the eyes, and she would hardly speak. This is a far cry from the bright, peaceful, and warm woman that I met.

Mary Bongo, now 65 years old, lives in the home her daughter builds with her own hands in the green hills of Londiani. This Mary lives a life where she speaks openly and stands confidently. She is loved and respected by her community, as she so deserves. Mary is evidence of the healing that love can provide.
