Imagine a transformation of the faces of 150 children in ten days of surgery in two countries. How will the dynamics of a family, community, and nation change with these vulnerable children's improved health?

The holistic vision of Love Without Reason continues onward in 2022. Uganda and Kenya medical camps launch in February. LWR will be working with each country's health and safety protocols to do everything possible to protect the children, staff, and volunteers. Anti-trafficking awareness campaigns for parents, healthcare workers, and volunteers will be crucial to our prevention, rescue, and recovery work in these nations. LWR's SafariCom grant in Kenya will fund our online speech therapy program allowing children to have free therapy sessions to improve their speech.

# MY "FRIEND" SOLD ME

My "Friend" sold me at the age of eleven. I was purchased by a brutal and hateful woman for an equivalent of \$200. As a child, I remember desperately fighting for my freedom - bargaining with this woman that I didn't want to do this work and wanted to return home. Her response was cold and transactional. "You can go back home. Pay me my \$200." That is when I went from a child to an abused slave for the next 15 years in Mumbai's red-light district.

At 26 years old, I finally made my way home. Home for a slave like me no longer existed. The stigma attached to me left me more alone than I had ever been. My family disowned me. Eventually, I married, only to be abandoned by my husband. No job, income, home, or support system left me hopeless.

For 15 years, I had been known as a slave and accepted as a product. I returned to Mumbai to be a slave. Several years later, exhausted from wandering and living in despair, I came to know and love Project Butterfly Center. For the first time since I was eleven, I again felt the kindness and love of humanity, finding a place of acceptance. Project Butterfly programs are teaching me to read and write. I have my first job as an entry-level tailor and can see a future where I can support myself and have my freedom. This is Aruna's story.

The impact of Project Butterfly is taking back our humanity one soul at a time. We are people, not products. You help people escape bondage to know freedom. Aruna's story is a painful one, but the beauty is the healing in her soul. With your partnership of prayers and financial support, we continue to work "Until There Are No More Sold!"

It isn't a simple process for those enslaved to escape bondage. Women who have steady incomes can care for their families, maintain the rent of their home, and provide education for their children.

The key to being brave enough to walk to freedom is illustrated by one of Project Butterfly's 2018 participants. A young woman who built her skills and confidence has maintained her independence and not returned to slavery. Despite her struggles in finding steady work, the hope and empowerment at the Project Butterfly Center have given her the strength to press forward. In fact, she informed Project Butterfly staff that she would be moving her family to another city for employment.

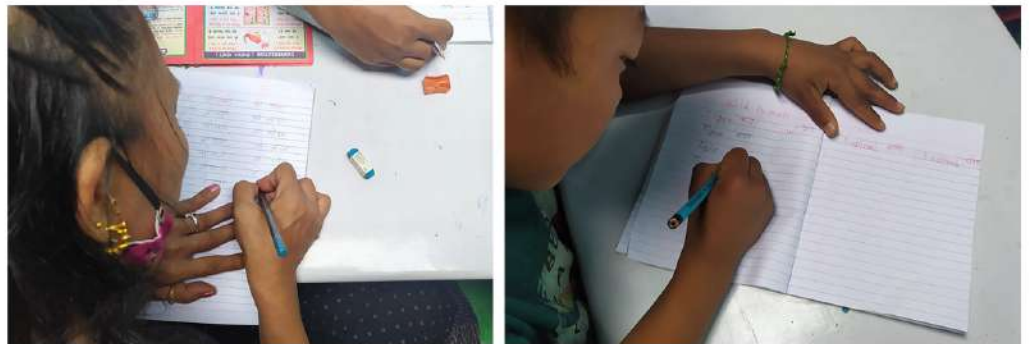


# EDUCATION AND EMPOWERMENT

Love Without Reason's Project Butterfly's initiative started in 2015, bringing life and hopes to women trapped in the red-light districts of Mumbai, India. We saw the path for individuals to escape bondage started with education. Many women were sold into the brothels as children and did not complete their education. The basic literacy skills were not present. In the beginning, the classes were small, a few women, but more and more shared their experience with Project Butterfly each year. The tide of women and children longing for escape has risen.

Modification, because of COVID, has allowed the classes to continue each Monday, Wednesday, Friday.

The classes are sponsored by our donors and cost-free to our participants. Each participant who can read and write organically comprehends -I am a person, not a product. These women now have the skills to take on new jobs and positions. Three of our amazing women have obtained work outside of the brothel environment. Ten women are working in the sewing center with LWR.

# OUTCOME

## Health is Vitalizing



Malnutrition is one of the leading causes of child mortality in parts of Africa. The impact is tangible with the appropriate feeding bottles to nourish and strengthen the children's health in preparation for cleft repair. Change happens at \$25/month.

## Education is Empowering



The women trapped in sexual slavery can access the teachers who share lessons on reading and writing multiple days of the week. This skill enables them to have a steady income with a job that provides for their family. Impact happens at \$50/month.

## Surgery is Transforming



The craniofacial repairs literally change the course of the future for these vulnerable children and adults, preventing them from being sold into organ trafficking networks. The protection happens at \$1000 a surgery or \$100/month.
