A Mother's Heart Changes

Govind was eleven days old when his father brought him to the first Bihar camp by Love Without Reason in February of this year. He was too young for surgery, and was sent back home after screening with the pediatrician. When Love Without Reason returned to Bihar for the next cleft mission in October, Govind's father brought him again on screening day.



The Love Without Reason team noticed that Govind's father carried him, the mother was nowhere to be seen. When asked about the mother, Govind's father teared up. After Govind was born, the mother fainted at the sight of her child. From that time she could not bear to see his face. The community harassed and humiliated her as well. Because of her agony, she avoided Govind.

After successful cleft lip repair, the mother was reunited with her son. She did not take her eyes off Govind. Her smile and joy spread to the entire team.

Leadership Training

During the Love Without Reason orientation sessions, the leadership identifies local leaders and teaches them about the "Love Without Reason Way." The principles of compassion, gentleness, love, and patience must be demonstrated to all the families who attend the cleft camps. This information in turn is shared with our volunteers who serve during the cleft camps in each country.



Linking Human Trafficking and Facial Differences

If the parents, volunteers and medical professionals are not able to identify human trafficking, then how will they know what to report? The Love Without Reason leaders, Mario and Syed, bring awareness on this critical topic during orientation. It is important to be sensitive to each culture and country where we provide cleft repairs.



Information Technology Training

Our local volunteers who join the cleft camps gather important information from each patient. Love Without Reason leaders Preethi and Askar take time to teach the volunteers on specific points in data collection and processing so that each patient is screened.

The dignity and health of women links with the mission of Love Without Reason to build a foundation of self-respect and value for each life. The Set Free Pads, the reusable sanitary napkins stitched by the women at the Project Butterfly Center, have opened doors for that foundation of self-respect and value to be formed.

Thousands of pads have been distributed in the red-light areas of Mumbai, India. During the cleft missions in India and in Africa, the mothers of the patients also received basic education on hygiene and the Set Free Pads.

With the demand for the pads rising, and the positive testimonials from women in different countries, plans for expansion of the Project Butterfly Center have been in discussion with the executive leadership.

The capital for this project is estimated at \$75,000.
