In a tiny village in West Bengal over 400 miles away from the capital city of Kolkata, baby Nandini was born. She was born into a community where girls are not valued. They are uneducated and treated with disrespect. Her parents were raised in this area and had never traveled outside their village. In their small community, no one had ever seen any craniofacial birth defects.

When Nandini was born with a cleft palate, the milk during her feedings would come back out of her mouth and nose. She was rejected by everyone in the community, except for her parents and her big sister. When she was three months old, she was finally examined by a doctor. This was when her cleft palate was identified as the reason for her malnourishment and inability to swallow milk. The family had limited resources and could not afford any modern methods for feeding. They used a spoon to feed their 3-month-old baby.

The months passed and the parents did their best to help Nandini feed and grow. They received a call about Love Without Reason and the free cleft camp in Kolkata, India. Nandini's mother put her fears aside about making the long journey to a strange city and focused on improving her child's chance at life and survival.

Director's Update

The end of 2022 was probably one of the busiest seasons of Love Without Reason with two cleft camps in two weeks in two countries - India and Kenya. We ended the year with a record four international cleft camps and one outreach camp inching Love Without Reason closer to the 1,000 surgery mark.

In the fight against human trafficking, Love Without Reason stepped up our awareness campaigns in Uganda, Kenya, Nepal and India, reaching over 2,000 women and children and giving them the good news and hope for the future. Our teams distributed over 600 kits with the Set Free biodegradable sanitary pads in the red-light areas to women who are being trafficked. We want to expand this project and distribute over 10,000 free kits over the next two years in the areas where the majority of the vulnerable women live.

As we speak, negotiations are underway for the next camp in Zimbabwe from March 26-31, 2023 and in Kenya from June 18-23, 2023. On average the medical camp prepares for 50 transformed smiles through free surgery. The cost of one camp is \$75,000 and the impact is immeasurable for children like Nandini. When you partner with Love Without Reason, together we are changing lives and changing destinies.

Rescue Children

Boys and girls were brought to Mumbai's red-light district to be sold into human trafficking networks. During the covid pandemic, many parents felt there was no alternative but to sell their children. Through the support of our partners, 22 children and women were rescued from the red-light area and taken to our partnering safehome, Asha Nepal. We are happy to report the health and well-being of these amazing survivors.

In 2022 we celebrated 105 new smiles of children and adults in three countries with a record F O U R medical camp. Two of these camps were in new locations, requiring a buildup of new partnerships, hospitals, and volunteers.
