# UGANDA MEDICAL CAMP



The government of Uganda accepted nearly 1 million refugees from South Sudan. The people are scattered in settlement camps across the country. The refugees are living dependent on the assistance of the Ugandan government and the humanitarian aid. Fear abounds, doubts, hopelessness and the suicide rate among the mothers is climbing.

Though there were challenges to obtain permission to bring the refugees out of the settlement camp, the Love Without Reason team worked hard and was successful in transporting the refugees from northern Uganda down south to Mbale Hospital. Twenty-one cleft lip and palate surgeries were done by the LWR medical team. Unfortunately, during the screening of the patients, children with malaria, anemia, malnourishment and pneumonia were also identified and sent for treatment. Their surgeries will be done at the next camp.

# WOMEN-LED ENTERPRISE

The mandate of Love Without Reason is to work until there are no more sold. How does this make an impact for women and children trapped in slavery? Women who survive the trauma of sexual slavery begin the reintegration process with understanding their identity and building their confidence.

In Uganda, Santhosh and Susan shared the story of their son Philip Mathews and their passion in eradicating sex trafficking through the work of Project Butterfly in Mumbai, India. The ladies quickly grasped the link between facial differences and human trafficking and decided to leave their imprint on the Uganda Medical camp as well. The Mbale Hospital needed surgical drapes. The ladies decided to stitch and design them. With the skills of these women and the equipment available, the plan to expand Project Butterfly into Uganda is fully on track.

The dignity and strength of the women when they contribute to society is something that the public can easily take for granted. The women of Project Butterfly identified the need for sanitary pads for women in the red-light area. A woman trapped in slavery will rarely be able to shop on her own. The dignity and confidence can be restored when she is able to care for her own health and hygiene. The reusable sanitary pad project was designed and researched by the women over the past two years. The ladies have mastered the sewing patterns and are preparing to launch the product.



# KENYA CLEFT CAMP, MARCH 2022

In February 2020, Kenya was buzzing with news about Love Without Reason mobilizing the entire country and discovering 325 cleft patients hidden in rural parts of the country. Over a period of four days, 75 patients received free cleft lip or palate repairs. When Covid ravaged the world, all camps were canceled until further notice.

Covid did not stop the Love Without Reason team, however. They continued to keep the dream alive for patients who were waiting for the medical teams to return. From February 6 – 11, 2022, the first LWR camp in Uganda was held where 21 free surgeries were done for children and adults. Due to the quarantines imposed on international travel into India, the Kenya camp was again postponed to March 13 – 18, 2022.

Based on our current mobilization statistics, we are projecting 100+ surgeries to be done at the mega camp at Kenyatta University Teaching Research and Referral Hospital. Our current projections estimate the cost of \$75,000 to complete the camp. Will you help us reach the goal and make the immeasurable impact on the lives of children and adults in Kenya?
