A MOTHER'S PLEA FOR HELP

Grace* was pregnant with her first child, when she discovered that her husband had a second wife and family. Feeling betrayed and vulnerable, she simply wanted to escape. She searched for jobs for many months after her daughter's birth. When her friend advised her he could help with a well-paying job at his company, she blindly followed him to Mumbai, India. To Grace, this friend "lit a candle in the darkness."

When they reached Mumbai, the friend forced her to work in the red-light district. She was emotionally and psychologically tortured, and she feared for the health of her then two-year-old daughter, Neema*. In hopelessness, she gave in and began to work as a sex slave. Over the next fourteen years, she worked for the pimps every day and went through forced abortions. In 2019, she developed cancer and died. Sixteen-year-old Neema had been protected for years by her mom, but after her death, she too was raped. Neema had no other dreams. She thought she would be trapped in the same life as her mother was and die in the same manner as her mother died.

The staff at Project Butterfly Center saw a different dream about Neema. They believe in #PhilipsDream. They want to see a world where children are not sold into slavery.



They began to work out a plan for Neema's escape. Late one night in June, Neema escaped the red-light district to the home of a friend in Mumbai. She was safe.

Her "father" was furious with the escape. Unfortunately for him, a resident near his home tested positive for COVID. His entire area went under quarantine and no one was allowed in or out of his area of the city. Neema remained in hiding.

Meanwhile on the other side of town, staff at the Project Butterfly Center witnessed a woman talking to known pimps. They described the argument as very heated and discovered that the woman was the mother of a nine-year old girl, Rena*. The mother was trying to sell Rena to the highest bidder. When the deal was not going as planned, the mother pulled away from the pimps. Our staff connected with the mother and talked to her about the future of her child. She consented to her daughter being transported to a safe home.

Thanks to the courage of the Project Butterfly staff, Neema and Rena are both in a safe home, miles away from the red-light area of Mumbai. They will receive education, medical care, counseling and most importantly, HOPE. Love Without Reason will continue the work to set captives free and bring beauty from the ashes.



ONCE CALLED A CURSE, NOW I AM A BLESSING

COVID-19 continues to wreak havoc among the most vulnerable. No, not with viral infections, but with harsher after-effects – STARVATION. Due to the lockdown in India, Kenya, and Zimbabwe, people have lost their jobs, and are unable to search for meaningful work. How will the families be fed with food?

When it comes to disaster relief and emergency management, link to human trafficking is revealed. Parents sell their children, women search for employment on the streets, and men look for any type of quick, get-rich scheme. The LWR global team began to mobilize funds, food, and the fight for our most vulnerable.

In Kenya, the LWR Board compiled the list of patients from the July 2018 and February 2020 missions. This included patients who were placed on a waiting list due to health concerns. After organizing these families by location, the team distributed bags of groceries filled with grains, proteins, hygiene kits and other essential items. ninety four families have been reached, including former patient baby Arafat. His mother, Awa, said that she prays every day for her 'daily bread.' They had not eaten at all that day. When the LWR team came with the bags of groceries, Awa cried. "My son, Arafat, born with a cleft lip, has brought blessing to our house. His lip was repaired with LWR in July 2018 at no cost to us. And now, we have food in our house, because he has brought LWR to us once again. He is a blessing to our home."
